

Printing:

- Print p.4 on cardstock single-sided
 - Print p.5 single-sided
- The rest will be double-sided as follows:
- p.15 on back of p.6
 - p.14 on back of p.7
 - p.13 on back of p.8
 - p.12 on back of p.9
 - p.11 on back of p.10

Assembly:

Lay cardstock with the printed side (cover) face down.

Place the single-sided info page (p.5) face up on top of the cardstock (printed face up).

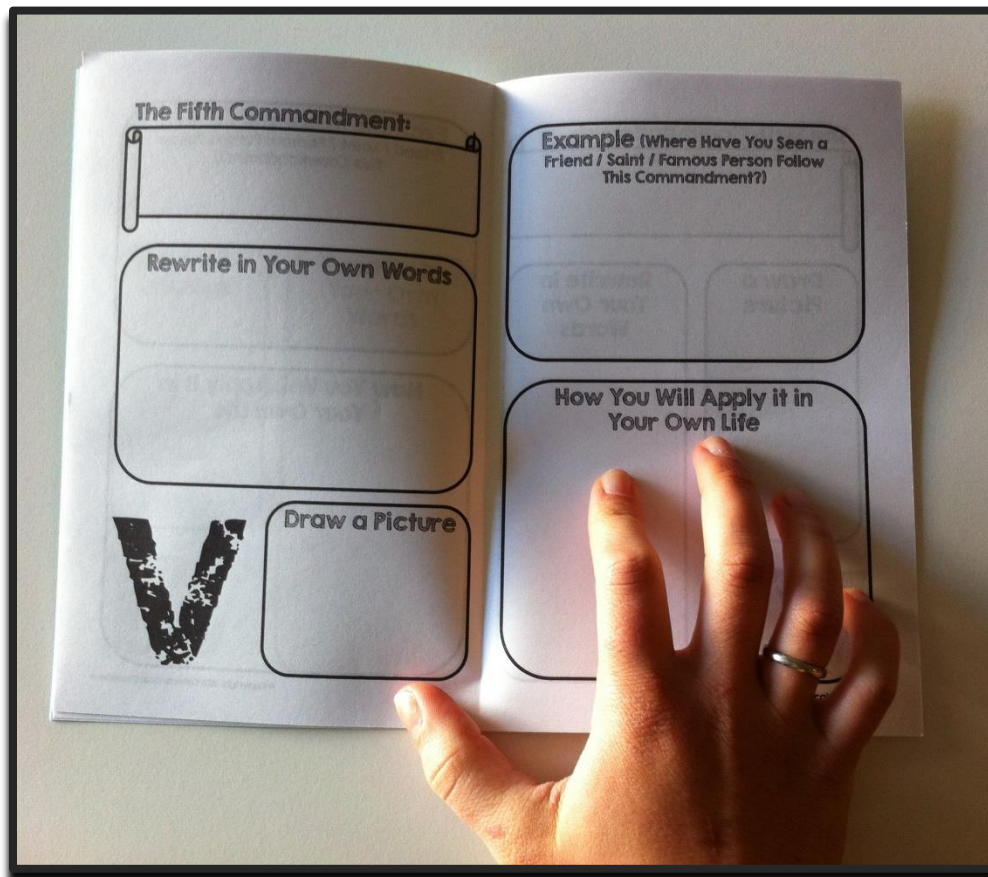
Lay the rest of the pages down on top, one at a time with these numerals facing up and in this order:
I first, then II, III, IV, V

Fold down the center of the entire stack and staple.



Tips:

- Use a variety of card stock colors, and let students choose a color! My kids loved picking their favorite colored booklet and personalizing it.
- Cover one Commandment per week, spread throughout a couple of months. Give only the Commandment, then allow some “think time,” and then a little writing and drawing time. Students must finish (at home if needed) before the next week.



- Before introducing each new Commandment, allow students to share out loud from the previous week if they wish to. I asked my student volunteers to choose and share only one box from the page, not all of it.
 - Have a few examples (particularly saints or celebrities) ready for students who are stumped on a person who is a good example. They love hearing the stories of a saint who followed a Commandment in a cool or different way!

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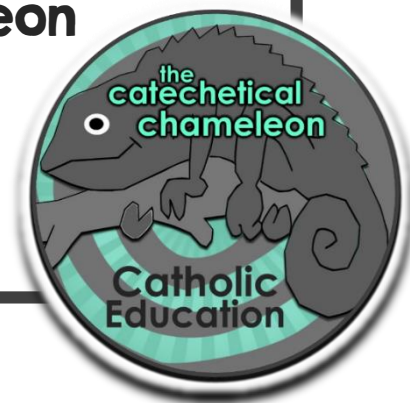
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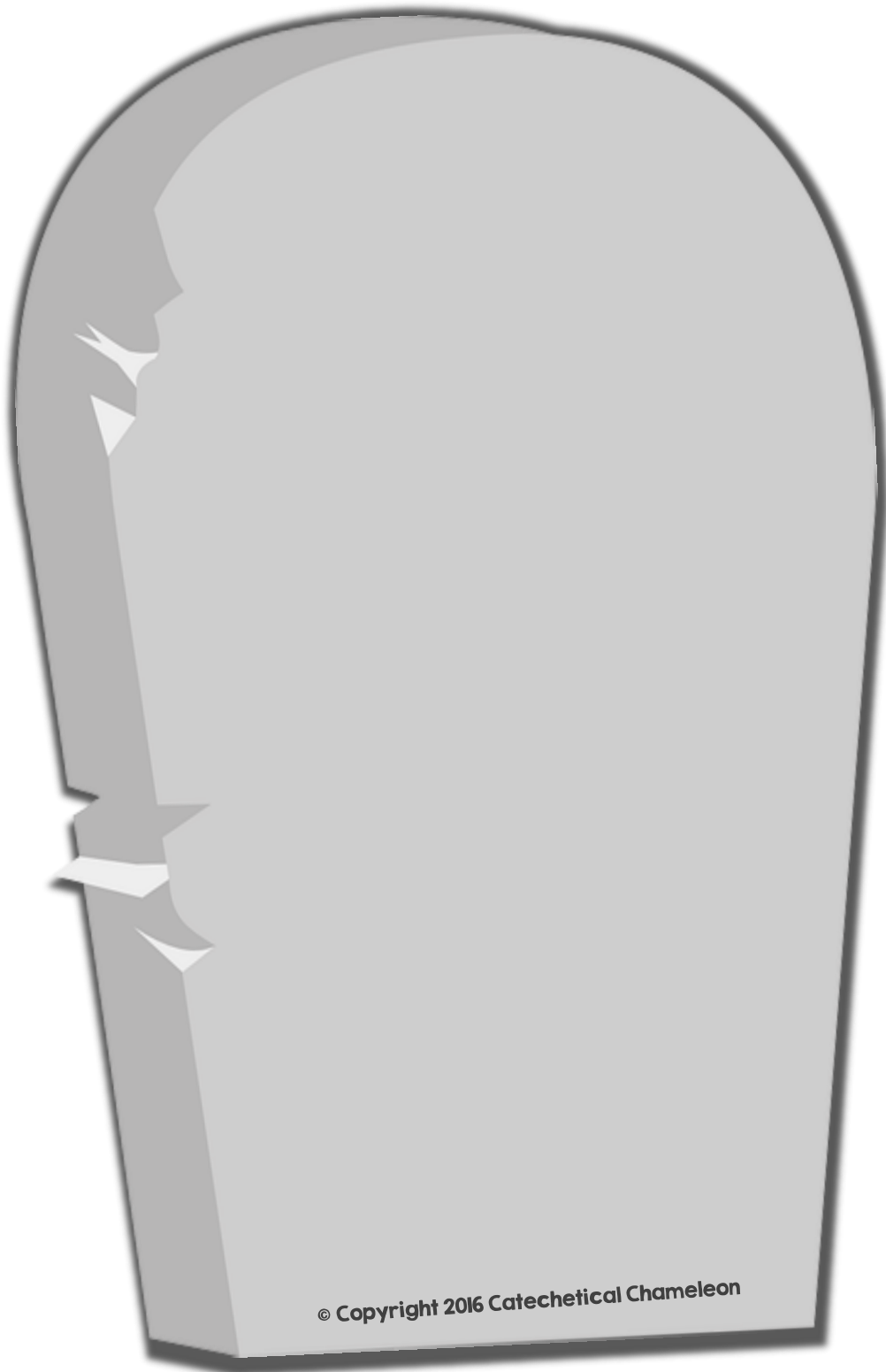
